

## 2010 TOWN OF TAOS REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION

### Who May Vote in the Municipal Election?

- **Any qualified elector whose name is shown on the signature roster of the Municipal Clerk. A qualified elector is** someone who is registered to vote with the Taos County Clerk. To vote in a municipal election, the **voter must reside within the Town limits**, where his/her residence is, as shown on the voter registration on file with the county clerk. (A voter who owns property, owns a business or has a Post Office box within the Town limits is not considered a qualified elector, **unless** he/she also resides in the Town limits).
- **If a voter's name is not on the signature roster**, he/she is permitted to vote upon providing his/her certified voter registration from the County Clerk's office, and upon swearing and affirming that he/she is a qualified elector (registered to vote with the Taos County Clerk no later than February 2, 2010) resident of the Town of Taos.
- **A person not entitled to vote who fraudulently votes or a person who votes or offers to vote more than once at any election is guilty of a fourth degree felony. A fourth degree felony is punishable by up to 18 months in jail and/or a \$5,000 fine.**
