**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TAOS  
DISPOSING OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL PROPERTY**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Taos own certain personal property which the Town is no longer in need of; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town has specifically identified such property as identified herein; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town believes it is in its best interest of the Town to dispose of said property pursuant to law.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Town Council of the Town of Taos:

The property identified herein is:

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the property is:

1. of a current resale value of \$5000 (five thousand dollars) or less; and
2. worn-out, unusable or obsolete to the extent that the item is no longer economical or safe for continued use by the Town; and
3. the property shall be disposed of by the following method:


Contractor shall recycle it.

## Change Order No. 1 to Contract TT-94-235

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This Change Order is hereby made and entered into by and between the Town of Taos, a New Mexico Municipality (hereinafter "TOWN") and 4A's (hereinafter "CONTRACTOR") on this 17<sup>th</sup> day of April 2006.

**WHEREAS**, the parties have found it necessary to enter this change order; and

**WHEREAS**, both the TOWN and the CONTRACTOR agrees to the terms and conditions of the change order;


**THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY MUTUALLY AGREED** by and between the parties that this contract shall be amended to include the following terms and conditions:

1. The aluminum plates covering the Don Fernando Pool are to be removed by the Contractor.
2. There will be no additional compensation under the terms of the original contract.
3. Contractor will recycle the aluminum plates and sell as scrap.
4. Contractor will be entitled to keep any proceeds from the sale/recycling of the aluminum liner.



# Memorandum

**RE:** Aluminum Plates at Don Fernando Pool Area

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The aluminum plates covering the entire Don Fernando Pool area need to be removed by the contractor due to the floor bubbling after performing some tests. This is not covered under the existing contract, but the contractor is willing to do it at no cost. He will recycle the aluminum plates to recover some of the cost. The demolition of debris will be under the \$5,000 cap. The contractor is authorized by the Town of Taos to sell it as scrap in lieu of increasing the contract. The estimated value is in the amount of \$1,000.00.

This will be done in accordance to the disposal process.
