



**TOWN OF TAOS
RESOLUTION NO. 06-47**

Requesting Additional Assistance from the US Environmental Protection Agency.

WHEREAS, the Town of Taos was awarded the Smart Growth Implementation Assistance grant from the United States Environmental Protection Agency; and

WHEREAS, Town of Taos benefited from the assistance through increased public awareness of the traffic and development issues along the Paseo del Pueblo Sur Corridor; and

WHEREAS, the grant resulted in a comprehensive report that outlined numerous recommendations for improving the mobility of traffic, safety of pedestrians, and accessibility of commercial developments along the Corridor; and

WHEREAS, the report also identified the Town of Taos Land Use Development Code as a hindrance to the type of development identified in the report; and

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the Town of Taos Town Council requests additional assistance from the US EPA for revising the Land Use Development Code to facilitate development that is consistent with the goals and recommendations of the report; and

Now, therefore, be it further resolved, if awarded additional assistance, that the Town of Taos will contribute in-kind resources through staff time and public meetings.
