



**TOWN OF TAOS
RESOLUTION NO. 07-11**

**Authorizing the Application to the US Environmental Protection Agency
Smart Growth Implementation Assistance Program**

WHEREAS, the Town of Taos was awarded the Smart Growth Implementation Assistance grant from the United States Environmental Protection Agency in 2005; and

WHEREAS, Town of Taos benefited from the assistance through increased public awareness of the traffic and development issues along the Paseo del Pueblo Sur Corridor; and

WHEREAS, The Paseo del Pueblo Sur Corridor consists of all commercial properties located along both sides of state highway 68 between Este Es Road and Camino de la Placita; and

WHEREAS, the grant resulted in a comprehensive report that outlined numerous recommendations for improving the mobility of traffic, safety of pedestrians, and accessibility of commercial developments along the Corridor; and

WHEREAS, the report also identified the Town of Taos Land Use Development Code as a hindrance to the type of development identified in the report; and

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the Town of Taos Town Council requests additional assistance from the US EPA for creating a Smart Code for the Corridor; and

Now, therefore, be it further resolved, if awarded additional assistance, that the Town of Taos will contribute in-kind resources through staff time and public meetings.
