

**TOWN OF TAOS
RESOLUTION 07-15**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF TAOS TO PARTICIPATE AND APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDING THROUGH THE 2007-2008 NEW MEXICO CLEAN & BEAUTIFUL PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Town of Taos, State of New Mexico, recognizes the existence of a litter problem within the boundaries of Taos, and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Litter Control & Beautification Act of 1985 provides, through the State Tourism Department, a Litter Control & Beautification Section for the allocation of public funds in the form of Grants for the purpose of enhancing local litter control and beautification programs; and

WHEREAS, the grant agreement requires a twenty-five percent (25%) match to the New Mexico Clean & Beautiful Grant Program share of seventy-five percent (75%), and

WHEREAS, having reviewed and considered the Regulations and Application covering administration and use of said funds; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in session this 20th day of March 2007 at the Regular Meeting of the Governing Body of the Town of Taos,

1. Requests the State Tourism Department, Litter Control and Beautification Section, to consider and approve said Application and Program, said Program being in accord with the regulations governing use and expenditure of said funds
2. It is the majority opinion of the governing body of the Town of Taos, it hereby authorizes Mayor Bobby F. Duran to plan, budget, and apply for a Grant which, if approved, will be used to fund said program.
