**APPROVING A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE NEW MEXICO HISTORIC
PRESERVATION DIVISION**

WHEREAS, the Town of Taos is the home of many nationally and internationally-recognized historic resources; and

WHEREAS, the economy of the Town of Taos is largely based on tourism, and

WHEREAS, many tourists visit the Town of Taos because of the rich history and the many museums, art galleries, plazas, and other historic resources located within the Historic Overlay Zone; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Overlay Zone is also the destination for many local residents who live, work, and play in the Historic Overlay Zone; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Taos Town Council has determined that it is necessary to complete a master plan to improve the walkability, accessibility, safety, and beauty of the Town of Taos Historic Overlay Zone in order to protect historic resources and to promote tourism; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Taos wishes to apply for the Certified Local Government grant with the New Mexico Historic Preservation Division to complete a Historic District Walkability Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Taos will commit \$5,000 as match funds from the 2007 Planning and Zoning Department budget.
