112 Civic Plaza Place is a partial two-story Spanish Pueblo Revival style adobe/stucco with a flat parapet that partially conceals a shed roof that drains east as evidenced by the deep overhang on the upper story. There is a single story attached garage on the west elevation with a wooden pedestrian entrance on the west and a folding panel vehicular door on the north. Windows are a mix of deeply recessed wooden units that are fixed plate glass with exposed/carved lintels and engaged columns, 6-lite casement units on the upper level, and 2- and 3-lite awning units. There are exposed vigas on the north, and a recessed portal with round posts, corbels, wood railing, and parapet on upper level west elevation. Entry to the building is through a single-leaf wooden storm door that protects the vertical plank entry door. There is a tile-covered overhang at the main entry. A low yard wall runs across the front of the property at the sidewalk. A taller yard wall with a pedestrian gate stands to the east of the building enclosing the side and rear yard.

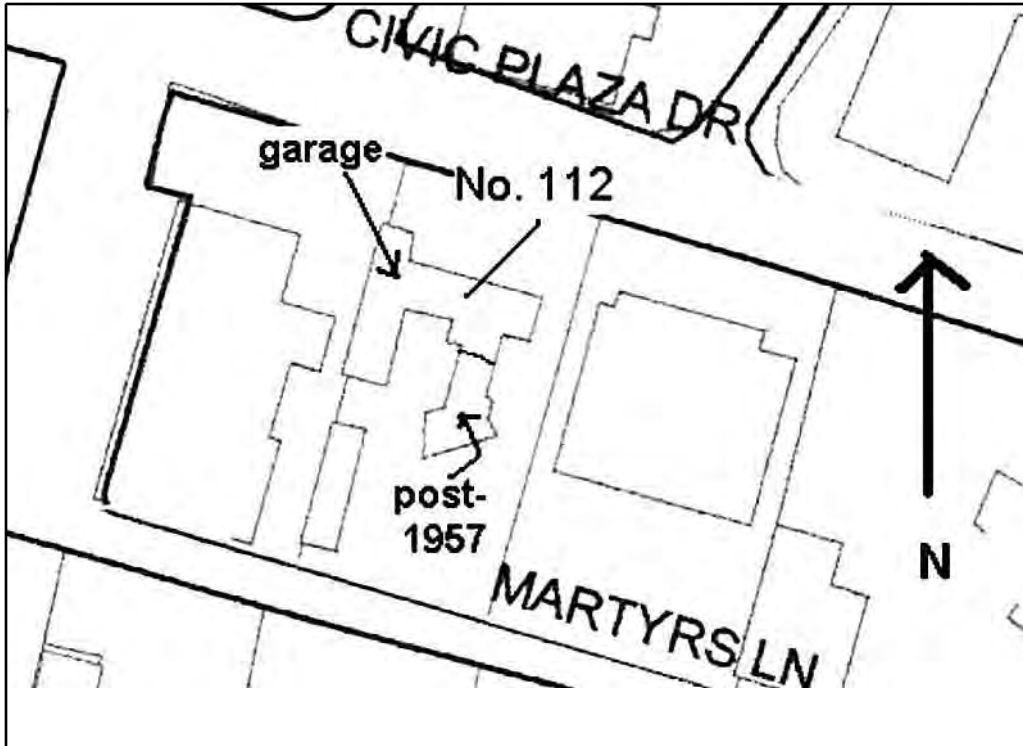

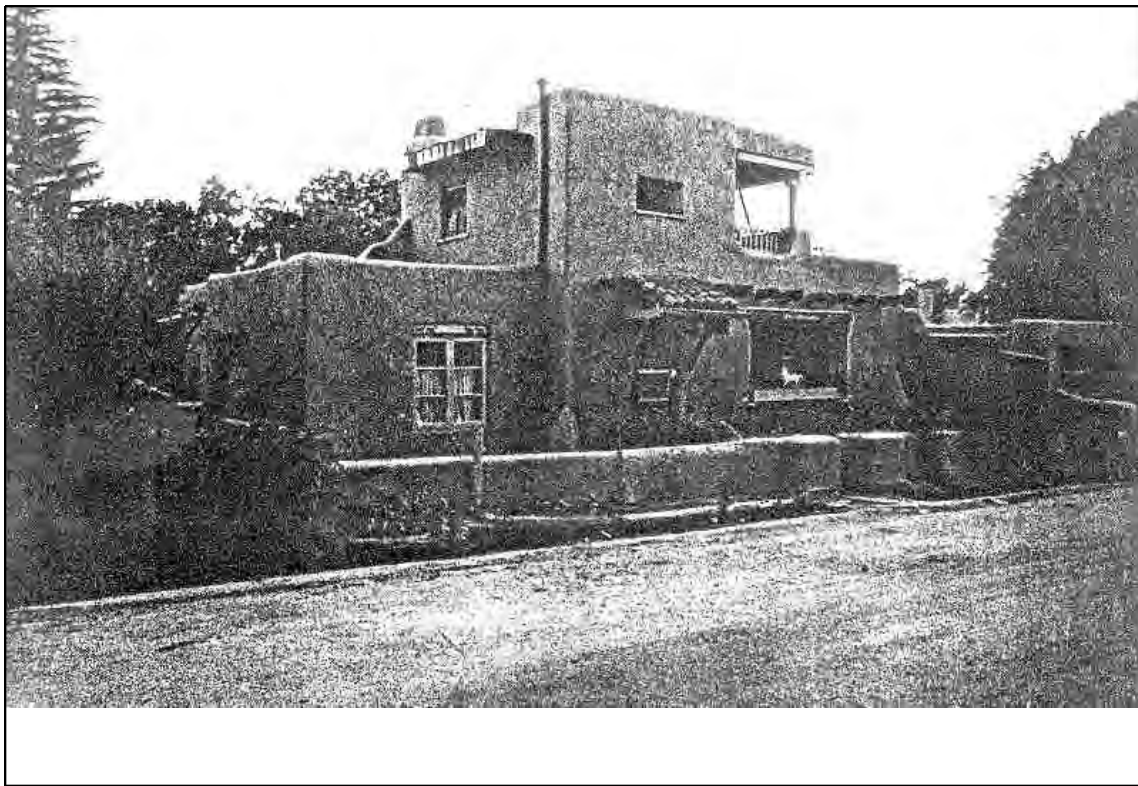
