DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY:

146 Paseo del Pueblo Norte is a single story white stuccoed adobe residence with an undulating parapet that steps up at the building corners. It displays features of the Bungalow and Craftsman styles. Windows are paired wooden double-hung one-over-one units. There are two fixed plate glass units on the north elevation and a bay window on the south elevation. A full-width porch with exposed joists, a shed roof, chamfered concrete posts, and river rock knee wall embellishes the east elevation. There is a single exterior chimney on the north elevation at the east end. The main entrance is through a single leaf wood panel and single window door with side lights and a wrought iron screen door. The site is framed with streets on 3 sides. There is a low twisted wire fence around the property perimeter with a pedestrian gate and concrete piers at the east side of the property. The building is surrounded by mature evergreen trees which make it difficult to fully view its architectural elements.

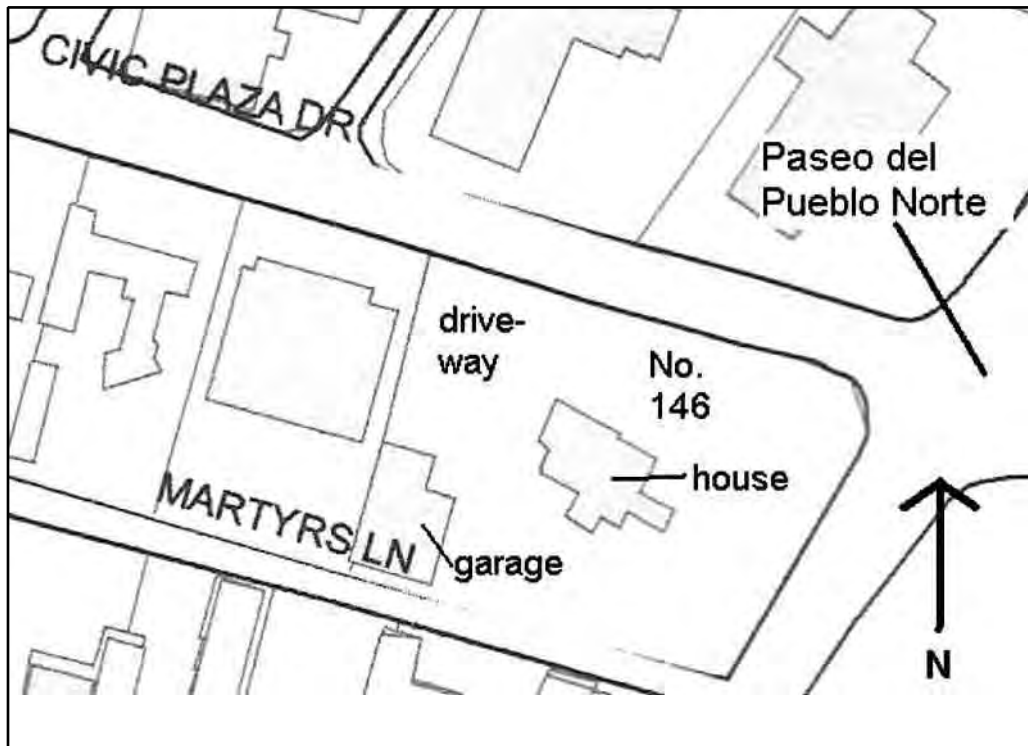
