DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY:

The Garage and Workshop at 146 Paseo del Pueblo Norte is a single story painted stucco structure with a gable roofline. The building's characteristic east parapet follows the gable form and steps up at the corners. There is a pair of 8-lite wooden casement windows on the south elevation. Roof joists project beyond the eaves. There are two wooden painted [blue] vertical slat doors on the east elevation which reflect the historic usage of the structure, one vehicular and one pedestrian. Lintels over the doors are exposed as are some viga ends on the south. The building sits at the southwest corner of its site with direct south frontage on Martyrs Lane. A chicken wire fence runs along the south side of the property.

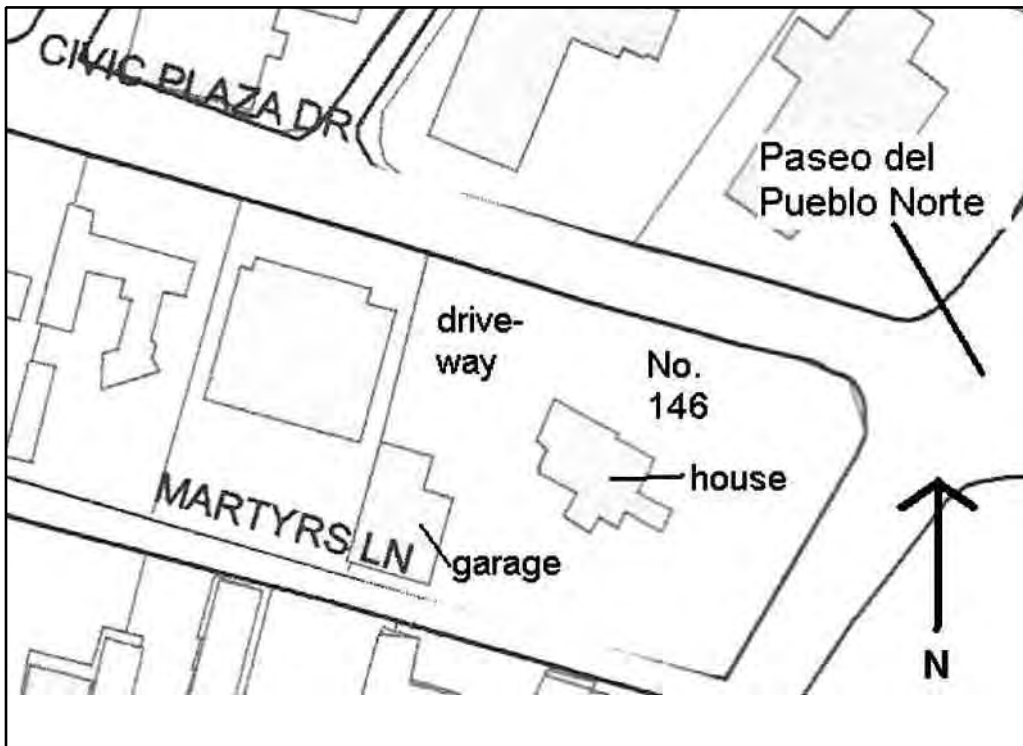
