DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY:

130 Bent Street is a single story pitched roof painted stucco on adobe structure with a gable roof covered with blue propanel. The paint scheme matches that on the building to its west, the former main house on the site. There is vertical wood panel infill under the gable. Windows are fixed plate glass and there is a 4-lite window unit on the south elevation. Access to the interior is through a recessed single-leaf wood and glass door on the east. There is also a low vertical panel wood door on the west elevation. Exposed vigas project from the wall on the north and south elevations. The building sits on a concrete foundation and is at the street on the bend in Bent Street.

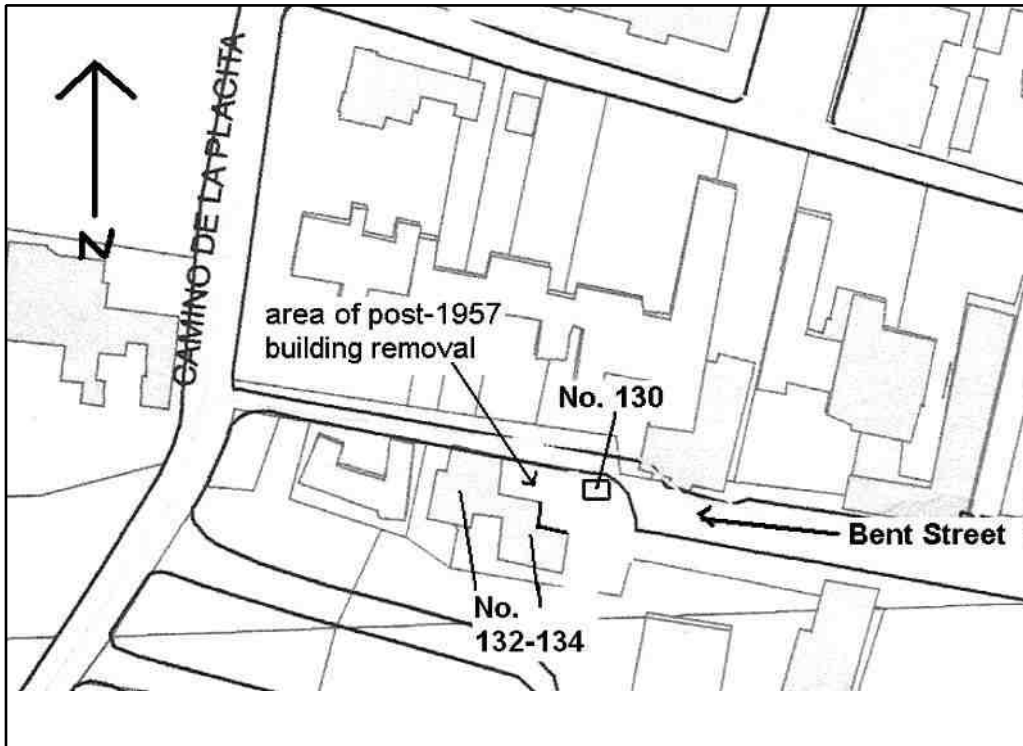
