DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY:

210 Paseo del Pueblo Norte is a single story stuccoed Spanish Pueblo Revival style residential building with a flat parapet. Windows are recessed 6-over-6 double-hung wooden units with exposed lintels on the east and south elevations. There is a single fixed plate unit on the east elevation. There is a recessed portal centrally located on the east elevation with a stucco pier and low knee wall. Its height is below that of the remainder of the house and it has projecting vigas. A secondary recessed portal with posts and corbels is centrally located on the south elevation. Both portales have painted dado areas under them. Doors are multi-lite wooden single leaf units. There are two interior chimneys on the south. A two-car garage with metal overhead doors is attached at the building's south elevation at the west end. There is a concrete ditch across the east end of the front yard.
