Windows are fixed plate glass storefront units. There is a portal with posts, corbels, canales, and lintel that wraps around the building's west and south elevations. The entrance to the building is through a single-leaf glass panel door on the west elevation. The building sits above street grade and there are centrally-located steps on the west which access a paved patio area in the front. A low block and stucco wall provides retaining for the patio.**

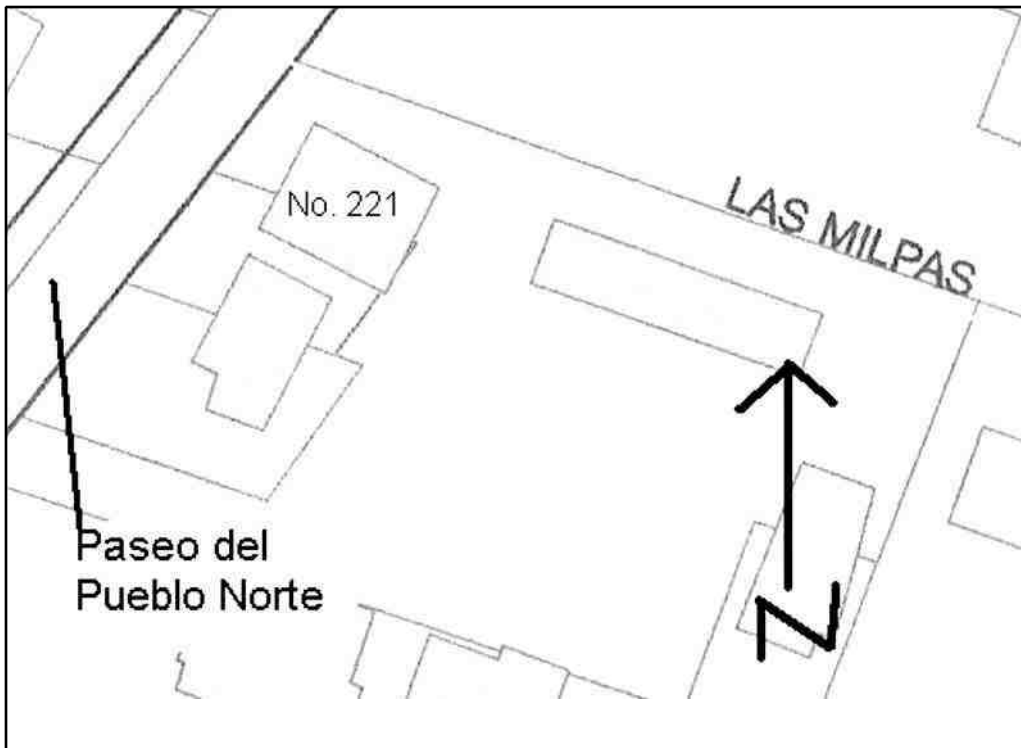
