DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY:

404 Paseo del Pueblo Norte is a single story Spanish Pueblo Revival style residential building. The building has a flat parapet that conceals the shed roof which slopes west. Windows are 6-over-6 wooden double hung units with trim placed in pairs and triplicate. There is a centrally located partial width portal with a shed roof and end parapets, posts resting on a knee wall, and corbels on the east elevation. Chimneys stand in the northeast and southeast corners of the building. A single leaf diagonal plank wood door on the east elevation under the portal provides the main entrance to the building. The building is substantially set back from the street with a large grassy yard with evergreens and cottonwood trees. There is also an acequia that traverses the front yard from north to south at the eastern end of it. A foot bridge crosses the acequia from the sidewalk. There is a low coyote fence at the sidewalk and a low stucco yard wall from the southeast corner of the house defining the southern yard area. A single car garage stands to the south and west of the building; it shares a common wall with the neighboring

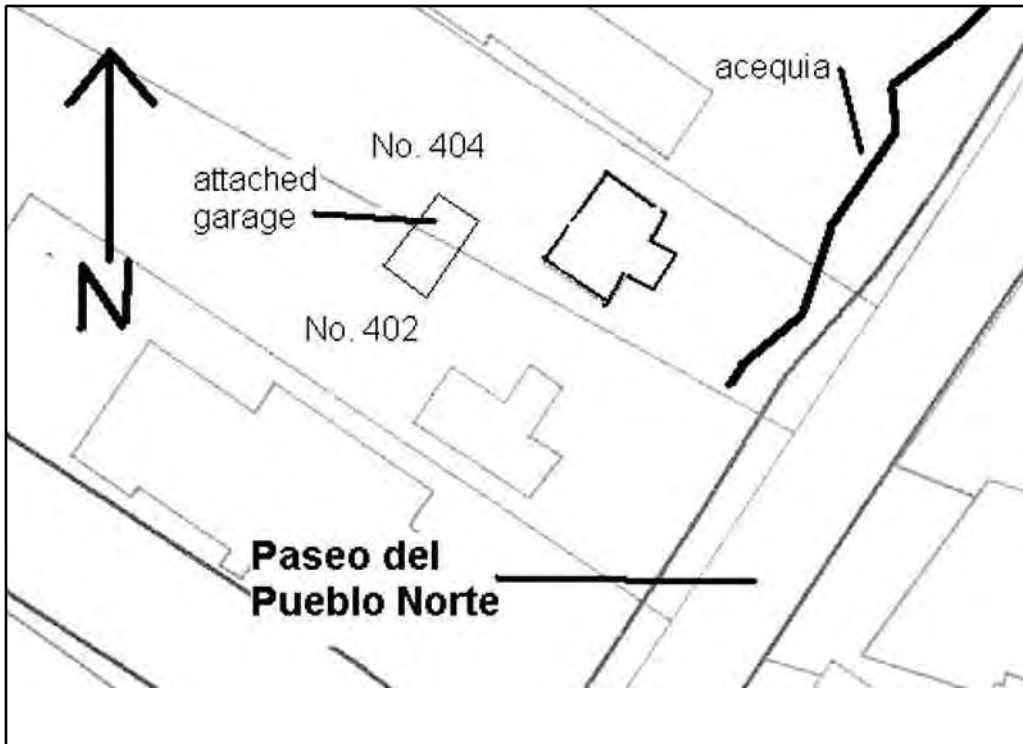

I spoke with Mr. Tarleton who had the following corrections to the HCPI Forms.

402 Paseo del Pueblo Norte (Dragonfly Restaurant):

- Correct the typo in the word “it” to “is” in the Description of Property section.
- He said there is not “evidence of an acequia”, there actually is an acequia.
- The date of construction is between 1912 and 1920.
- The bay window is not a modification. It is original.
- The north wing is an addition and was build between 1944 and 1945.
- He believes the use as a restaurant is “dissimilar” to the surroundings.
- The building was purchased by his father in 1926.
- The property line is in the middle of the existing garage.

404 Paseo del Pueblo Norte (Kilgore medical office):

- It should be called the “Harry & Minnie Tarleton House & Garage”.
- His family bought it from Mr. Brisban.
- The date of construction is between 1928 and 1930.
- It was built by Harry Tarleton, not Tom Tarleton.
