DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY:

Building #5 at 412 Paseo del Pueblo Norte [Rooms 301 – 406] is a two-story stuccoed Spanish Pueblo Revival style structure with a flat parapet. Windows are 1-over-1 paired double-hung vinyl units on the east elevation. A two-level full-width portal runs across the east and west elevations. The portales are details with round posts and corbels, and a wooden railing across the upper level. Canales punctuate the parapet on the portales. The ground floor units are separated by stepped half-walls under the roof of the portal. The west elevation also has an enclosed stairwell which provides access to the upper level units. At the north and south end of the building, there are clustered exterior chimneys. Entry to the units is through single-leaf wooden and glass doors with wooden storm doors. The structure is located at the northwest part of the site and faces a grassy lawn to its east.

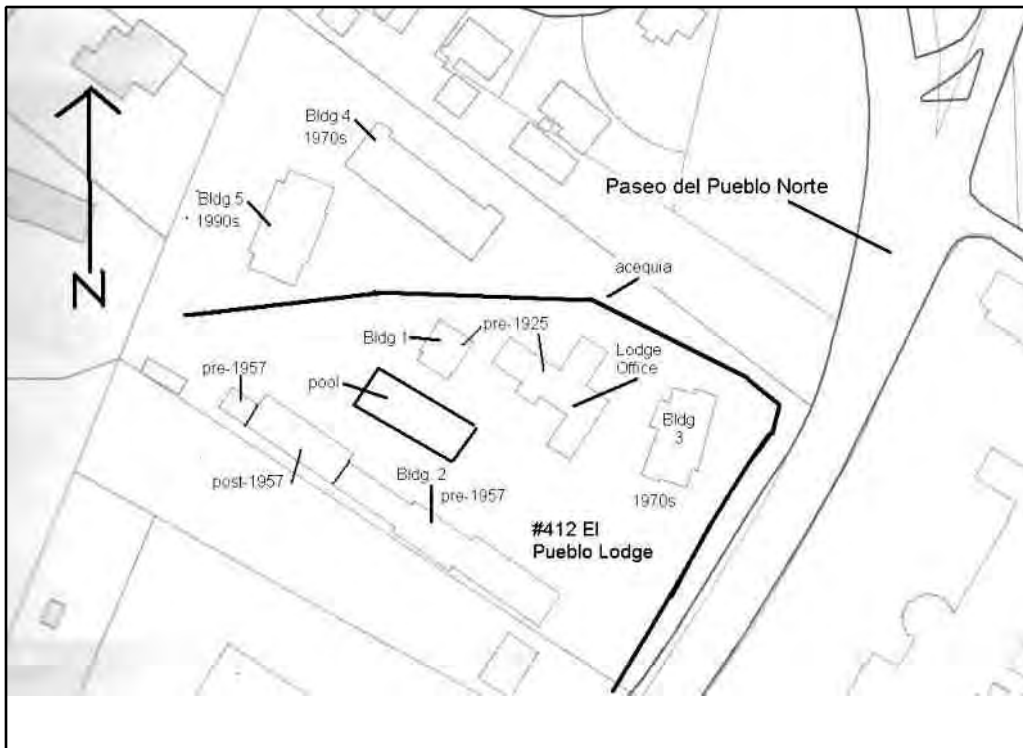
