DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY:

Building #6 at 413 Paseo del Pueblo Norte [Kachina Lodge] is the Shalako Casitas. It is a two-story stuccoed Spanish Pueblo Revival style lodge structure with a flat parapet. It has large undivided aluminum windows with slider sidelights. A recessed two-story portal extends across the length of the north elevation. It has posts which support corbels, exposed lintels, and a jigsaw-cut wooden railing at the second floor. First floor ceiling vigas project through the portal. Entry into the units is through single-leaf solid core wooden doors. Windows and doors have exposed lintels. The western end of the structure has a single story angular commercial space with street frontage. Windows are wooden 10-lite storefront units set in triplicate and quadruplicate. There are transom windows as well. Entrance to the commercial space is through a single-leaf wooden panel door with grillwork. There is a storefront overhang with a blue awning across the length of it. Parking is provided both to the west and north of the building which stands at the southwest corner of the property.

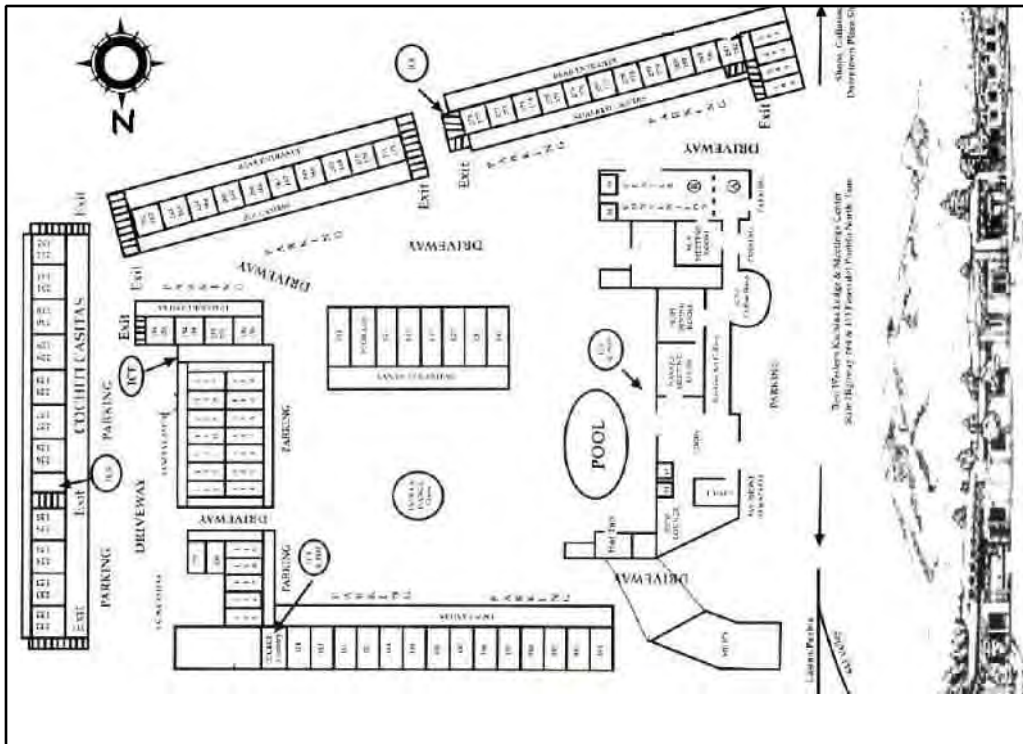
