DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY:

311 Paseo del Pueblo Norte is a single story stuccoed warehouse structure with two levels of building mass. The eastern mass is higher than that of the west/front. Flat parapets conceal the low gable and shed rooflines. Corner buttresses and a projecting central mass detail the west front. Windows are limited to the storefront on the west and include 3 rows of 6-lite wooden units set in quadruple. Entrance to the building is through a single leaf 12-lite wooden unit set within the storefront. There is a single centrally-located interior chimney. A massive hanging sign hangs on the west front over the sidewalk. The building occupies a corner lot at Montano Lane. There is a low railroad tie planter in front of the building at the sidewalk.

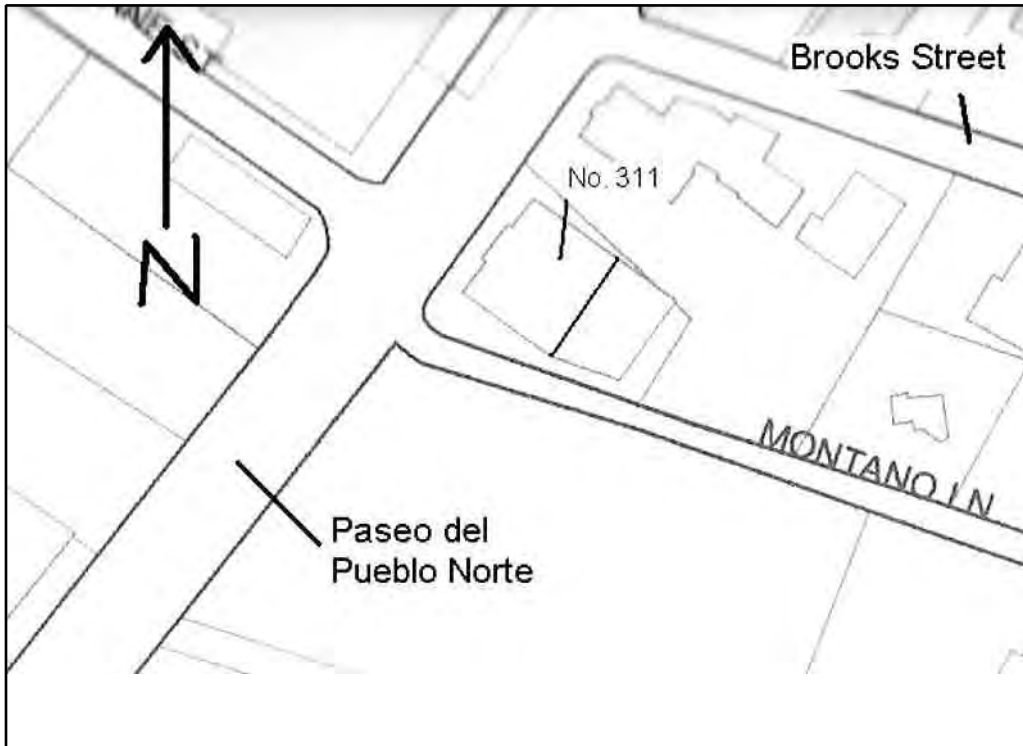
