## DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY:

303 Paseo deo Pueblo Norte is a single story Spanish Pueblo Revival style stuccoed commercial structure with a stepped parapet which conceals a roofline that sheds to the south. Exposed vigas decorate the west façade. Windows are large fixed plate glass units with carved lintels. A central raised entrance is recessed on the west with double-leaf glass and wood doors. There is a low stucco wall along the front of the property at the sidewalk. Visibility of the historic portion of the structure is minimal on the south elevation. There are large evergreen and cottonwood trees on the site which further conceals the historic area of the building. Visible details on the historic portion include 6-over-6 double hung wooden windows, and a lean-to porch at the southeast corner.

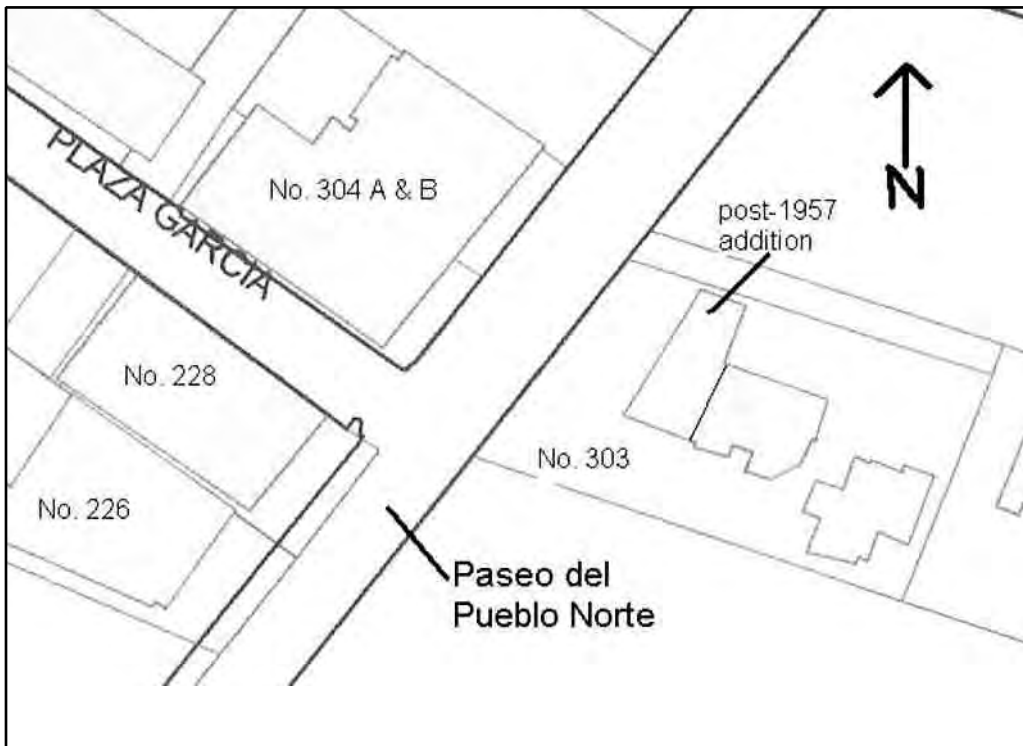
