DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY:

The small pitched roof structure on the site addressed at 205 Don Fernando Street is constructed of adobe and finished in textured stucco. It has a high gable roof covered with modern dark green Propanel material. Windows are modern paired 2-over-2 double hung clad units with exterior wood trim. There is a small shed-roofed partial width portal at the southeast corner with carved posts and corbels. A similarly designed pitched roof covered walkway connects this structure to the building immediately to the south. There is an exterior chimney on the west end. The main entrance is on the south side of the building through a deeply recessed wood panel single leaf door and decorative wood screen door located at the placement of the covered walkway. A secondary entrance of similar design exists under the portal. The structure stands on packed dirt or asphalt paved parking area immediately south of the Taos Elementary School.

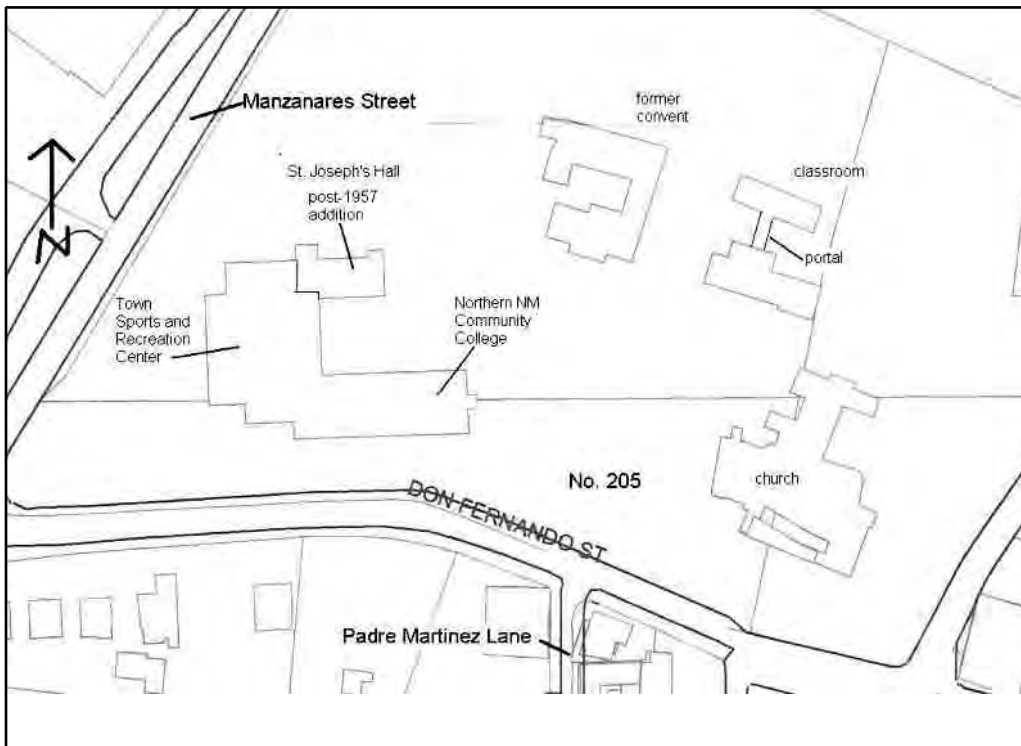
