214 Don Fernando Street is a tall single story stuccoed Spanish Pueblo Revival style structure with a stepped parapet on its high central mass and shed roofs on its east and west wings. There are paired 12-lite casements with divided lite transoms on the north elevation of the central mass. Other windows are 4- and 6-lite wooden casement units on the wings. Decorative viga ends project from the north elevation of the building. There are canales on the east elevation. There is a low stucco yard wall with an arched pedestrian gate separating the gravel parking area to the north of the structure and a landscaped patio area. The building sits nearly at 0 lot line along the south of the property. There is a 2 car garage to the building's east that was surveyed separately as #2005072.

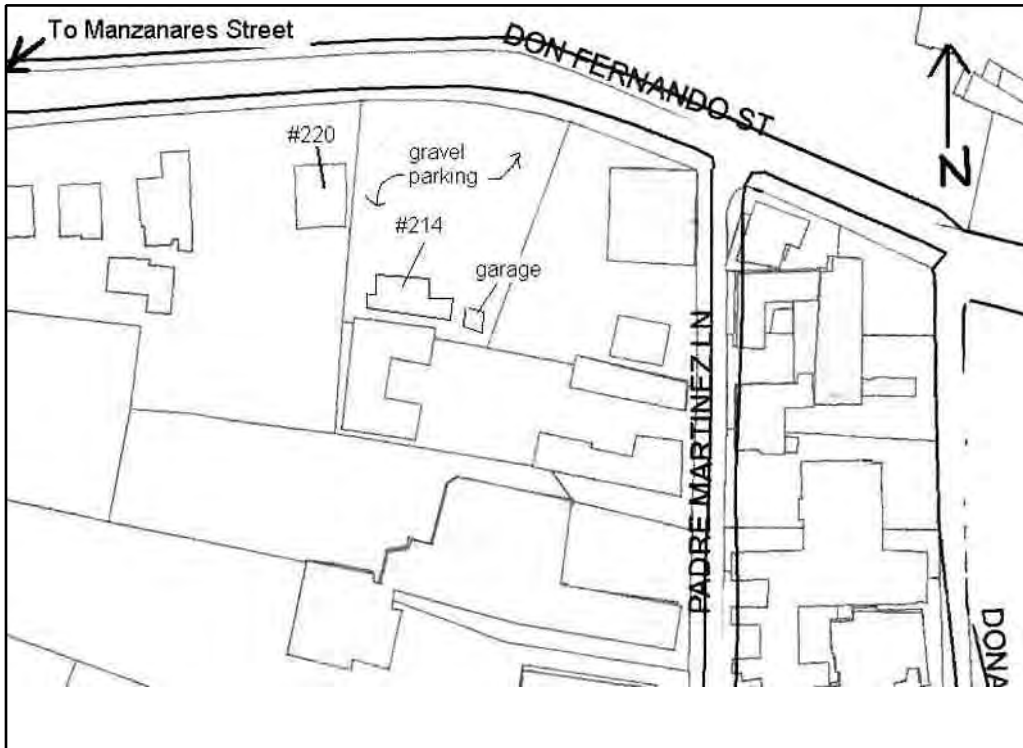
