RESOLUTION NO. 08-27**

A RESOLUTION REPLACING RESOLUTION 08-23, REVISING THE STANDARD
POLICY ON FOOD AND ALCOHOL SERVICE AT THE TAOS CONVENTION CENTER

Whereas, the Town of Taos Council has made available the Taos Convention Center for use by the general public; and

Whereas, the general public rents the Town facility and provides food and beverages for events; and

Whereas, it is in the best interest of the Town to allow the general public the ability to rent a wide range of food and beverage services.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY, THE TOWN OF TAOS COUNCIL that the following is the policy of the Town council as related to the serving of food and alcohol at the Taos Convention Center and this policy shall become effective July 1, 2008:

- 1) **Food Catering Services** will be open to any applicant that obtains the appropriate catering permits from the State of New Mexico Environment Department and complies with all applicable laws, rules and regulations related to catering.
- 2) **Beverage Catering Services (Alcohol Services)** will be open to any applicant that obtains the appropriate licensing from the New Mexico Regulation and Licensing Department Alcohol and Gaming Division and complies with all applicable laws, rules and regulations. Event service will be through the procurement of a Special Dispenser Permit
- 3) The applicant must obtain a current Town of Taos business license.
- 4) The applicant must provide proof of insurance up to the limits of the New Mexico Tort Claims Act.
- 5) The applicant must provide the Taos Convention Center Director with current copies of all fully executed licenses, permits, and insurances prior to execution of any event at the Taos Convention Center.
- 6) The applicant agrees to follow all rules and procedures for use of the Taos Convention Center as determined by the Taos Convention Center Director and the Town of Taos.
- 7) The applicant agrees to pay all fees, commissions, or deposits required by the Town of Taos.
- 8) The applicant understands they may be held liable for any damages to property and facilities as determined by the Taos Convention Center Director and the Town of Taos.
- 9) The Town of Taos may place its Governmental liquor license in suspension effective July 1, 2008 and reserves the right to reactivate the license at its sole discretion with the approval of the Alcohol and Gaming Division.
