36           Councilmember Sanchez expressed concern that several of his comments were  
37           not included in the minutes. Mayor Cordova informed Councilmember Sanchez  
38           that a copy of the DVD is available for public record. Councilmember Sanchez  
39           stated he would like to review the DVD and have Renee Lucero, Town Clerk,  
40           amend the minutes at a later date.

41

42           Mayor Cordova recommended changing page 5, line 14, replacing the last  
43           sentence with the following: “There was a general consensus between the  
44           Councilmembers.”

1           **Councilmember Quintana made a motion to approve the Minutes of the May**  
2           **13, 2009, Special Meeting as amended. Councilmember Silva seconded the**  
3           **motion. The motion was approved by an affirmative vote. Those voting**  
4           **AYE were: Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta and Councilmembers Quintana and**  
5           **Silva. Councilmember Sanchez abstained from the vote.**  
6

- 7           **B.** Decision and Order including Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law  
8           regarding Valverde Commons Application for a Zone Change and Planned Unit  
9           Development. Vote on this item will be preceded by consideration of the  
10           Decision and Order, and consideration of Town of Taos Ordinance 09-10  
11           amending Town of Taos Ordinance 06-21, Official Zoning map of the Town of  
12           Taos and Ordinance 99-05, The Town of Taos Land Use Development Code,  
13           rezoning 12.3 acres of land from Residential Agricultural zoning district; 1.33  
14           acres of land from the County Rural Area (RA) zoning district, and .6 acres of  
15           land from the Single Family Residential (R4) zoning district (14.23 +/-acres total)  
16           to the Single Family Residential (R2) zoning district with a Planned Unit  
17           Development (PUD) Overlay district. The property is located at 600 Valverde  
18           Road. Vote on this item will be preceded by consideration of points made in  
19           parties' proposed Findings and Conclusions.  
20

21           Mayor Cordova asked Allen Ferguson, Town Attorney, if the opponents received  
22           the Decision and Order including Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law and  
23           were they were given a chance to respond.  
24

25           Mr. Ferguson stated yes and that Mr. Alan Maestas, Attorney for the opponents,  
26           asked that a supplement to Mr. William H. Burden, Jr.'s testimony be included as  
27           part of the record. Mr. Ferguson stated he does not feel it is proper to receive this  
28           supplement because the record has already been closed.  
29

30           **Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta made a motion to approve the Decision and Order**  
31           **including Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law regarding Valverde**  
32           **Commons Application for a Zone Change and Planned Unit Development**  
33           **amending page 3, paragraph 11, line 4 adding “him to donate up to 2.5 acres**  
34           **and” after the word “enabling”. Councilmember Silva seconded the motion.**  
35           **The motion was approved by an affirmative vote. Those voting AYE were:**  
36           **Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta and Councilmembers Quintana and Silva.**  
37           **Councilmember Sanchez abstained from the vote.**

- 39           **C.** Decision and Order including Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law  
40           regarding the appeal of the Valverde Commons final plat approval. Vote on this  
41           item will be preceded by consideration of the Decision and Order in the appeal to  
42           Case No. P&Z 200721 Final Plat Approval Acequia de los Sanchez, Acequia Los  
43           Lovatos, Ranchitos Ditch and El Molino Acequia Association, Appellants, Alan  
44           H. Maestas, Maestas & Boothby, P.C., agent; appealing the Planning and Zoning  
45           Commission decision to approve the Final Plat for the Valverde Commons 28 lot  
46           Subdivision. The property is located at 600 Valverde Road within the Single  
47           Family Residential (R2) and Planned Unit Development Overlay zoning districts

1 of the Town of Taos. Vote on this item will be preceded by consideration of  
2 points made in parties' proposed Findings and Conclusions.

4 Mr. Ferguson reviewed the hearings which took place in the past regarding  
5 Valverde Commons. Mayor Cordova stated that Jack Clough, Assistant Town  
6 Attorney, prepared the Decision and Order including Findings of Facts and  
7 Conclusions of Law regarding the appeal of the Valverde Commons final plat  
8 approval, and was not the attorney during the previous proceedings.

9  
10 **Councilmember Quintana made a motion to approve the Decision and Order**  
11 **including Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law regarding the appeal of**  
12 **the Valverde Commons final plat approval amending page 2, paragraph 5,**  
13 **line 6 adding “as well as approving annexation, zone change and planned**  
14 **unit development overlay” after the word “considerations”. Mayor Pro Tem**  
15 **Abeyta seconded the motion. The motion was approved by an affirmative**  
16 **vote. Those voting AYE were: Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta and**  
17 **Councilmembers Quintana and Silva. Councilmember Sanchez abstained**  
18 **from the vote.**

## 8. CITIZENS FORUM

### A. Sue Goldberg and Rebeca Romero-Rainey, presentation from Bridges Project.

Rebeca Romero-Rainey came forward and explained the Bridges Program. She stated education is the root of economic development and explained the Bridges Program exists to provide additional college guidance to high school students. She also stated the purpose of her presentation is to make the community aware of their program.

Mayor Cordova stated the Town of Taos is available to provide in-kind services due to budgetary restraints.

## 9. CONSENT AGENDA

**The Mayor presented the following consent agenda to the Council. He read each item on the agenda and advised the Council they could request any item be removed from the consent agenda if they desired to discuss such item:**

### A. Francella Garcia, Grants Administrator

1. Authorization to submit 3 grant applications in the amount of \$35,000 each to the New Mexico Tourism Department Cooperative Marketing Grant Program. Funding will be used to promote Taos as a tourist destination. For every dollar awarded the Town will be required to match twice the dollar amount. Town Match will be double the amount received (already met in preliminarily approved 2009-2010 budget).
2. Authorization to submit a grant application to the State of New Mexico Department of Transportation (DOT), Aviation Division for a crack seal project for Runway 4/22 at the Taos Regional Airport in the amount of \$68,341. Proposed funding breakdown is as follows: State 80% (\$68,341); Town Match 20% (\$17,085). Proposed project amount \$85,426.
3. Authorization to submit a grant application to the State of New Mexico Department of Transportation (DOT), Aviation Division for taxiway and ramp pavement maintenance and taxiway reflectors at the Taos Regional Airport in the amount of \$3,750. Proposed funding breakdown is as follows: FAA 95% (\$150,000); State 2.5% (\$3,750); Town Match 2.5% (\$3,750). Proposed project amount \$157,500.
4. Approval of Resolution 09-25 authorizing the Town of Taos to participate and accept grant funding through the 2009/2010 New Mexico Clean and Beautiful Program. Grant Agreement No. 10-418-6001-0049 from the New Mexico Clean and Beautiful is in the amount of \$2,500 for the purpose of enhancing

1 local litter control, beautification programs and youth employment programs  
2 to aid in litter control and beautification projects.

3 **B. Amos Torres, Public Utilities Director**

- 4 1. Consideration and approval to award Contract #TT-09-326 to TLC Plumbing  
5 & Utility for the Camino del Medio Pipebursting project. TLC Plumbing &  
6 Utility was the lowest bidder. The total amount of the contract is \$330,742  
7 plus NMGRT. The project is located along Camino del Medio from State Rd  
8 240 to Paseo del Canon West.
- 9 2. Consideration and approval of Amendment # 2 to Contract TT-09-115 with  
10 Waste Management of New Mexico for the hauling and disposal of biosolids  
11 from the Taos Valley Regional Wastewater Treatment Facility to the Rio  
12 Rancho Landfill. The amount is \$106,000. Amendment is for the cost of  
13 biosolid hauling and disposal to complete the fiscal year. Contract will expire  
14 June 30, 2009.

15 **C. Matthew Foster, Long Range Planner**

- 16 1. Approval of Resolution 09-27 approving the grant application to the Historic  
17 Preservation Division for funding to hire an architecture historian to work  
18 with the staff, Historic Preservation Commission, the Town Council, and the  
19 public to revise the architecture standards for new construction; and to revise  
20 the design review process for the Historic Overlay Zone and for two public  
21 workshops to provide information and applications for federal and state  
22 financial incentives for improvements to historic structures.
- 23 2. Approving the Memorandum of Understanding between the Town of Taos  
24 and the New Mexico Department of Transportation for the Safe Routes to  
25 School grant in the amount of \$15,000.

26 **Councilmember Sanchez asked to removed item 9.A.1. from the consent agenda for**  
27 **discussion.**

28  
29 **Councilmember Silva asked to remove item 9.B.2. from the consent agenda for**  
30 **discussion.**

31  
32 **Councilmember Silva made a motion to approve the consent agenda as amended.**  
33 **Councilmember Sanchez seconded the motion. The motion was approved by an**  
34 **affirmative vote. Those voting AYE were: Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta and**  
35 **Councilmembers Sanchez, Quintana and Silva.**

36  
37 **9.A.1. Francella Garcia, Grants Administrator**

38 Authorization to submit 3 grant applications in the amount of \$35,000 each to the  
39 New Mexico Tourism Department Cooperative Marketing Grant Program.  
40 Funding will be used to promote Taos as a tourist destination. For every dollar  
41 awarded the Town will be required to match twice the dollar amount. Town  
42 Match will be double the amount received (already met in preliminarily approved  
43 2009-2010 budget).  
44

1 Councilmember Sanchez stated he believes the Town should focus more on  
2 making Taos a high altitude training center rather than focusing so much on  
3 advertising.

4  
5 Mayor Cordova stated that although tourism has slowed down, the Town should  
6 not lose focus on advertising. He recommends not cutting the advertising budget.

7  
8 Councilmember Quintana agreed and stated the Town needs to encourage people  
9 to keep visiting Taos.

10  
11 Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta stated the Council supports Taos becoming a sports  
12 destination, but believes money should be left in the advertising budget.

13  
14 **Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta made a motion to authorize the submission of 3**  
15 **grant applications in the amount of \$35,000 each to the New Mexico Tourism**  
16 **Department Cooperative Marketing Grant Program. Councilmember**  
17 **Quintana seconded the motion. The motion was approved by an affirmative**  
18 **vote. Those voting AYE were: Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta and**  
19 **Councilmembers Sanchez, Quintana and Silva.**

20  
21 **9.B.2. Amos Torres, Public Utilities Director**

22 Consideration and approval of Amendment # 2 to Contract TT-09-115 with Waste  
23 Management of New Mexico for the hauling and disposal of biosolids from the  
24 Taos Valley Regional Wastewater Treatment Facility to the Rio Rancho Landfill.  
25 The amount is \$106,000. Amendment is for the cost of biosolid hauling and  
26 disposal to complete the fiscal year. Contract will expire June 30, 2009.

27  
28 Councilmember Silva asked Daniel Miera, Town Manager, to evaluate if the  
29 Town can haul biosolids rather than contracting with Waste Management. Mr.  
30 Miera stated the Town is close to breaking ground on the composting facility and  
31 will then have zero costs.

32  
33 Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta stated the Town should find a cost effective way to  
34 dispose of the sludge.

35  
36 **Councilmember Quintana made a motion to approve Amendment # 2 to**  
37 **Contract TT-09-115 with Waste Management of New Mexico.**  
38 **Councilmember Sanchez seconded the motion. The motion was approved by**  
39 **an affirmative vote. Those voting AYE were: Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta and**  
40 **Councilmembers Sanchez and Quintana. Voting NAY was: Councilmember**  
41 **Silva.**

1 **10. PUBLIC HEARINGS**

2 **A. Renee Lucero, Town Clerk**

3 Consideration and approval of a new Restaurant Beer & Wine Liquor License  
4 Application 593497 for Lula's LLC dba Lula's located at 316 Paseo del Pueblo  
5 Sur.

6  
7 **Renee Lucero, Town Clerk, presented the application to the Mayor and  
8 Council and stated all publication requirements have been met.**

9  
10 *Public Opinion*

11 **Mayor Cordova opened the public hearing. No one came forward.**

12  
13 **After closing the public hearing, Mayor Cordova asked for questions from  
14 the Council.**

15  
16 **Councilmember Sanchez made a motion to approve the new Restaurant Beer  
17 & Wine Liquor License Application 593497 for Lula's LLC dba Lula's  
18 located at 316 Paseo del Pueblo Sur. Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta seconded the  
19 motion. The motion was approved by an affirmative vote. Those voting  
20 AYE were: Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta and Councilmembers Sanchez and  
21 Silva. Councilmember Quintana did not vote because she stepped out of the  
22 meeting temporarily.**

23  
24 **B. Francella Garcia, Grants Administrator**

25 1. Public hearing for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)  
26 application(s). The purpose of this public hearing is to receive public input on  
27 community development needs and suggestions for future projects.

28  
29 **Francella Garcia, Grants Administrator, read the CDBG guidelines.**

30  
31 *Public Opinion*

32 **Mayor Cordova opened the public hearing. No one came forward.**

33  
34 **After closing the public hearing, Mayor Cordova asked for questions  
35 from the Council.**

36  
37 This item was to receive input from the community; therefore, no action was  
38 taken.

39  
40 2. Public hearing for the project closeout of the Planning Community  
41 Development Block Grant (CDBG) in the amount of \$17,000. In 2007 the  
42 Town of Taos was awarded the CDBG Planning grant to prepare the High  
43 Performance Building Ordinance (HPBO). Per the requirements of the CDBG  
44 Grant Agreement, a public closeout hearing to report the use of CDBG funds  
45 is required.

1           **Francella Garcia, Grants Administrator, presented the item.**

2  
3           ***Public Opinion***

4           **Mayor Cordova opened the public hearing. No one came forward.**

5  
6           **After closing the public hearing, Mayor Cordova asked for questions**  
7           **from the Council.**

8  
9           This item was to receive input from the community; therefore, no action was  
10          taken.

11  
12          **C. Allen Ferguson, Town Attorney**

- 13           1. Adoption of Town of Taos Ordinance 09-12; an Ordinance to amend  
14           compensation and benefits provisions for at-will employees of the Town of  
15           Taos repealing and replacing various sections of Chapter 3.64 of the  
16           Municipal Code.

17  
18           **Allen Ferguson, Town Attorney, presented Ordinance 09-12.**

19  
20           **Mr. Miera stated that one of the recommendations during the**  
21           **implementation of the Employee Pay & Classification Plan in December,**  
22           **2008, was to evaluate the benefits of exempt employees. He stated all**  
23           **employees are now classified except the 5 employees who are required by**  
24           **law to remain exempt.**

25  
26           ***Public Opinion***

27           **Mayor Cordova opened the public hearing. No one came forward.**

28  
29           **After closing the public hearing, Mayor Cordova asked for questions**  
30           **from the Council.**

31  
32           **Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta stated this ordinance will allow the 5 exempt**  
33           **employees to negotiate their benefits and he is totally in support of the**  
34           **ordinance.**

35  
36           **Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta made a motion to approve Ordinance 09-12.**  
37           **Councilmember Quintana seconded the motion. The motion was**  
38           **approved by an affirmative vote. Those voting AYE were: Mayor Pro**  
39           **Tem Abeyta and Councilmembers Sanchez, Quintana, and Silva.**

- 40  
41           2. Continuation of Public Hearing from April 14, 2009: The purpose of the  
42           hearing is to consider the Dedication Agreement between Town of Taos and  
43           David Sperry dated August 2, 2006.

44  
45           **Allen Ferguson, Town Attorney, stated David Sperry's Attorney, Lee**  
46           **Boothby, is in the audience and handed out a Settlement Agreement**

1           **between the Town of Taos and David Sperry and Resource Development**  
2           **Systems, Inc. Mr. Ferguson stated the Town of Taos is reconveying the**  
3           **2.714 acres that Mr. Sperry had quit claimed to the Town and the parcel**  
4           **shall again become one contiguous parcel. Mr. Ferguson further stated**  
5           **Mr. Sperry agrees to have a lien placed on the property in the amount of**  
6           **\$92,459.18.**

7  
8           ***Public Opinion***

9           **Mayor Cordova opened the public hearing. No one came forward.**

10  
11           **After closing the public hearing, Mayor Cordova asked for questions**  
12           **from the Council.**

13  
14           **Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta made a motion to approve the settlement**  
15           **agreement and allow the Town Attorney to make changes to the**  
16           **agreement if needed and also authorize the Mayor and Town Attorney to**  
17           **sign the settlement agreement on behalf of the Town of Taos.**  
18           **Councilmember Sanchez seconded the motion. The motion was approved**  
19           **by an affirmative vote. Those voting AYE were: Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta**  
20           **and Councilmembers Sanchez, Quintana, and Silva.**

21  
22           **11. MATTERS FROM STAFF**

23           **Marietta Fambro, Finance Director**

24           **A. Approval of Resolution 09-26 Budget Adjustment Request:**

  - 26           • Utility Improvements Fund (81) - Decrease interfund transfer in and decrease
  - 27           Bedford Pumps Project (81-97) in the amount of \$46,573 in order to transfer
  - 28           out money to Wastewater Fund to cover sludge hauling to Rio Rancho, NM;
  - 29           • Wastewater Fund (63) - Increase interfund transfer in from Fund 81 in the
  - 30           amount of \$46,753 and Other Contractual Services to cover additional sludge
  - 31           hauling to Rio Rancho, NM with Waste Management of NM.

32           **Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta made a motion to approve Resolution 09-26.**  
33           **Councilmember Quintana seconded the motion. The motion was approved**  
34           **by an affirmative vote. Those voting AYE were: Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta**  
35           **and Councilmembers Sanchez, Quintana, and Silva.**

- 36  
37           **B. Approval to enter into a contract with Accounting & Consulting Group, LLP for**  
38           **the Town of Taos Annual Audit fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 in the amount**  
39           **of \$37,500 plus NMGRT (\$2,531.25), contingent on approval from the Office of**  
40           **the State Auditor. This is the first year of a possible three year award based on an**  
41           **informal RFP process established.**

42  
43           There was a discussion regarding using the same auditors for several years.  
44           Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta recommended using new auditors after three years.  
45

1           **Councilmember Quintana made a motion to approve the contract with**  
2           **Accounting & Consulting Group, LLP for the Town of Taos Annual Audit**  
3           **FYE June 30, 2009. Councilmember Silva seconded the motion. The motion**  
4           **was approved by an affirmative vote. Those voting AYE were: Mayor Pro**  
5           **Tem Abeyta and Councilmembers Sanchez, Quintana and Silva.**  
6

## 7           **12. MATTERS FROM THE TOWN MANAGER**

8           Report from the Town Manager.

9  
10          Mr. Miera stated he will continue evaluating all items brought up at today's meeting.

11  
12          Mayor Cordova asked the Council to review the email sent by the Human Resources  
13          Director regarding the Town Manager's evaluation in July, 2009. He also informed  
14          the Council that he is meeting with each Department Head regarding policy matters  
15          and the general direction of the Town.

16  
17          Mr. Miera stated performance evaluations of all Town employees will be completed  
18          on a regular basis, beginning with his performance evaluation. He stated it is  
19          essential for each employee to know how they are performing.

20  
21          Councilmember Quintana asked Mr. Miera for a briefing on the summer clean-up.  
22          Mr. Miera stated staff is continuing the beautification efforts. He stated the next  
23          clean-up is scheduled for June 18, 2009, at Ledoux Street and another clean-up is  
24          being planned for Kit Carson Park.

25  
26          Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta stated he would like a written response by Mr. Miera  
27          regarding 22 action items which were emailed by him to Mr. Miera. Mr. Miera stated  
28          he will have a written response to Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta by this Friday, June 12,  
29          2009.

## 30 31           **13. MATTERS FROM THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL**

32          Councilmember Silva stated he is glad to hear about the clean-up of Kit Carson Park.  
33          He stated he went on a walk-through of the park and a piece of sidewalk by the  
34          cemetery had been vandalized and has needed repair for quite some time. He would  
35          like for it to be fixed. Mr. Miera stated he will follow up on this issue.

36  
37           **14. ADJOURNMENT: A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Abeyta and**  
38           **seconded by Councilmember Quintana to adjourn the meeting. The motion**
